Uganda Martyrs University Library subscribes to a number of online resources available through the Library website (<http://library.umu.ac.ug/>). Due to contractual and licensing agreements, these resources are only available to Uganda Martyrs University staff and currently enrolled students, and requires authentication. This guide therefore, is to show you the place to input the Username, and password.

Step one: Go to: library.umu.ac.ug, you will see this page below

Step two: At the Quick Access Menu click on Off Campus Access



Step Four: Database and Journals list after Logging in

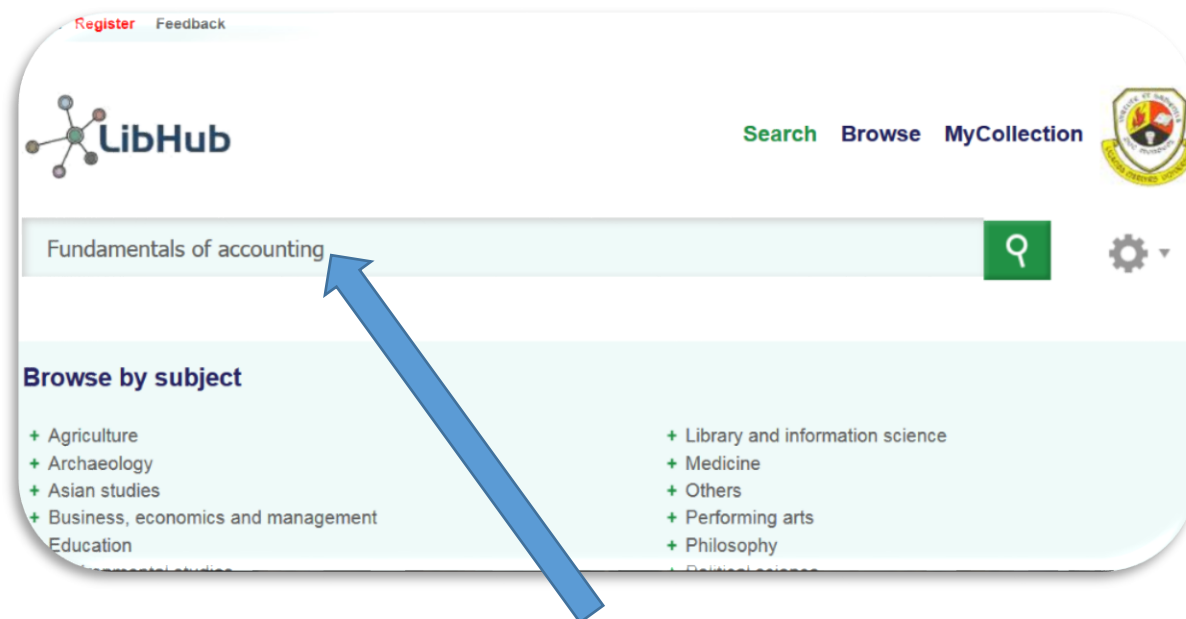
